Vendor Access Protocol

All vendors entering the community must comply with the following requirements and procedures:

1. Licensing and Insurance

- All vendors must be properly licensed and insured.
- Vendors are required to present valid proof of license and insurance to Security upon arrival.
- Entry will be denied without proper documentation.

2. Check-In Procedure

- Vendors must check in with Security at the front gate before entering the community.
- A valid government-issued ID may also be required.
- Security will verify authorization for entry.

3. Hours of Operation

- Vendors are permitted access Monday through Saturday between:
 - 7:00 a.m. – 6:00 p.m.
- No vendor access or work is allowed on Sundays.
- No vendors on Holidays.

4. Resident Responsibility

- Residents are fully responsible for their vendors at all times.
- Residents must ensure vendors are aware of and comply with all community rules and regulations.

5. General Rules for Vendors

Vendors must adhere to the following while on property:

- **The maximum speed limit within the community is 25 mph.**
- Contractor vehicles must be parked on one side of the road only and must not be parked on grass or obstruct traffic flow.
- Loud noise is prohibited.
- No signs, advertisements, or postings may be placed anywhere within the community.

- **Soliciting is strictly prohibited.**
- Vendors are not permitted to use community dumpsters.
- All work areas must be kept clean, organized, and free of debris.
- Vendors will be held fully responsible for any damage to community property.
- All work performed must be in full compliance with county codes and **regulations.**

Failure to comply with any of the above may result in denial of entry or removal from the community.
